



Parents, guardians, and students:

Student success in math is linked to regular practice in the grade level skills. Over the summer, students at Annunciation Catholic School will be required to complete online math work designed to maintain and extend foundational math skills. This summertime practice proves very beneficial to the students' retention of math facts.

Each student *entering* grades 6 through 8 will have a personalized summer IXL math requirement based on the student's performance in class and on the Iowa Assessment. Instructions for logging in will be sent home in a letter that will accompany each student's fourth quarter report card.

In order to obtain full credit, students must reach 85 points on each skill within the "Topics" assigned. We encourage all students to use outside resources (the internet, old notes, books, etc.) to help them complete the work.

Please know that these requirements are not optional and will affect your child's grade in the coming school year.
